South Kingstown Farmers Market Bylaws

Rules and Regulations Established 2009

1. No member may buy items and resell them at the market. Members can sell what they grow or products they produce at the market. See market manager for exceptions.
2. Farm and non-farm vendors must provide a list of the produce, value added items, products, etc. that you intend to sell at the SKFM.
3. Vendors must supply all required **current*** permits, licenses, sales tax permits and any other required information for the sale of their items each year. Each vendor is responsible for meeting all applicable state, federal and local laws and regulations for items they sell. *Please make sure your permits/licenses are up to date and renewed when appropriate. A **RETAIL SALES PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR ALL VENDORS.**
4. Dues are non-refundable and must be paid in full before the season begins.
5. Vendors are assigned a spot and should set up in that spot each week. Please keep your area clean and neat and provide a wastebasket if necessary.
6. Vendors should be set up and ready for business before the start time of the market and should be dismantled and cleaned up within an hour after the market ends. A \$25 dollar fee for late arrivals can be charged at the discretion of the market master. Set ups should be neat and safe. Always be prepared for wind. Tents must be secured with stakes/weights
7. Farm or business name must be clearly displayed.
8. Clearly display names and prices of items. (Clearly written list of prices is perfectly acceptable)
9. Please refrain from starting sales before the official starting of the market which is 8:30 am. Manager can make exceptions so please speak with them. A \$25 fine **can** be enforced for each violation.
10. All scales must be certified.
11. Sales shall be conducted in an orderly manner. Vendors shall exhibit courtesy and cooperation to the vendors as well as customers. No Vendor shall engage in solicitation, collection drives, political or religious activities in the market. No loud hawking of items is allowed. These rules are intended to keep the market a neutral and inclusive space.
12. Members must notify the market manager **ahead of time** if they cannot attend a market.
13. All members must read and abide by the rules and bylaws. The market master and/or designate shall have authority to mediate and enforce the market rules only as needed.
14. Please speak with the market manager if you need to leave early **ever**. It's important for all vendors to be at the market for the open time period.
15. No alcohol or smoking is allowed.
16. Vendors who fail to comply with SKFM bylaws are ineligible for SKFM insurance coverage.

Failure to comply with the above requirements and SKFM by laws will jeopardize participation membership to the farmers market.
